Prospective Registrants who wish to use the Service shall agree to these Terms and Conditions and apply for Registration in the prescribed manner.

GFP reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice.

(Purpose)

 GFP registration Terms and Conditions are for farmers, foresters, fishermen and other producers and their organizations, food business operators, distributors, distributors and other business operators, local governments, etc. (hereinafter referred to as "producers, etc.")

This stipulates matters to be complied with when registering with GFP.

(Registration requirements)

- 2. Prospective Registrants who wish to use the Service is necessary to be a producer, etc. who meets the following requirements.
- (1) Make a GFP declaration as a determination to actively engage in the export of agricultural, forestry and fishery products and foods.
- (2) Agree that your name (company name, organization name, etc.), address, industry, etc. will be widely publicized on the GFP community site as a GFP registrant.
- (3) Information such as company name, department name, address, industry, production items, products handled, sales area, etc.) will be disclosed between GFP registrants.
 - (4) Able to contact with GFP secretariat by email or a phone number when required.
 - (5) Not applicable to the following conditions.
 - ① Crime groups, gang members, associate members of organized crime groups, companies related to organized crime groups, corporate racketeers, gangsters claiming to be social movements, organized crime groups with special intelligence, and other equivalent persons (hereinafter referred to as "anti-social forces").
 - 2 Five years have not passed since the person ceased to be an anti-social force.
 - 3 The user or a person who is substantially involved in its management has a relationship with anti-social forces that should be socially condemned.

(Menu details)

GFP provides producers, etc. registered with GFP (hereinafter referred to as "GFP members") with useful information for exporting for GFP members to access to the information and support needed for exports.

This includes services for export diagnosis, on-site diagnosis, and matching for GFP members, with GFP members agreeing to the Terms and Conditions for each service when using these individual services.

(Purpose of use of personal information)

- Other registration information, including personal information provided by GFP members, will be used for the following purposes.
 - (1) Export diagnosis and on-site diagnosis
 - (2) Matching service between GFP registrants
 - (3) Information provision on export-related information and effective supports
 - (4) Other services deemed necessary by the GFP Secretariat

(Registration procedure)

5. If you wish to register with GFP, please fill out the GFP registration form and apply.

(Logo)

6. The GFP logo is used to increase recognition of GFP and to increase the sense of solidarity among registrants. GFP Members wishing to use this logo for business purposes should apply to the GFP Secretariat for approval in advance regarding the purpose and application of use.

Please note that this logo cannot be affixed to products.

(Non Disclosure Agreement)

 GFP members are requested not to disclose, publicize, or divulge information about individual companies shared among GFP members to third parties, unless it is agreed in advance.

(Handling of personal information)

 Personal information of GFP members obtained by GFP Secretariat will be managed appropriately based on the Act on the Protection of Personal Information Held by Administrative Organs (Act No. 58 of May 30, 2003).

The same applies when handling the personal information for the following organizations

related to the work of GFP;

Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, Ministry of Finance and their local branch offices, local governments, independent administrative agencies, Japan External Trade Organization, and private business operators entrusted by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries.

(Cancellation of Registration)

9. A GFP member who wishes to cancel the registration of GFP can cancel the registration by submitting a "Notification of Cancellation of Registration" to the GFP Secretariat. At the time the registration is canceled, the submitter will no longer be a GFP member.

(Reject of registration)

- 10. The GFP Secretariat may cancel the registration of a GFP member if any of the following apply.
 - (1) When recognized that the member have committed an act that violates laws and public order and morals.
 - (2) When recognized that the member has acted to the detriment of the GFP Member, GFP Secretariat or a third party, such as providing false information.
 - (3) 2. When recognized that the member no longer meet the registration requirements
 - (4) When recognized that the member have violated these Terms and Conditions.

(Link settings)

- 11. In principle, users are free to link to the top page of the GFP official website. However, this does not apply if there are notes such as link restrictions in each information.
- 12. When setting up a link, users are requested to contact the authorities in advance by describing the content and URL of the link source site, the purpose of the link, etc.
- 13. In principle, users should link to the top page of the GFP official website (http://www.gfp1.maff.go.jp) when posting a link. If you wish to post a link to a page other than the top page for some special reason, please contact the relevant authorities.
- 14. When setting a link, please clearly indicate that the link is to the GFP website.
 - Please note that we may ask you to change the linking method or delete the link depending on the linking method or the content of the page.
- 15. If the authority determines that the content of the link source site falls under any of the following items, the authority may take necessary measures such as suspending or deleting the link
 - (1) Contrary to public order and morals
 - (2) To contain content that violates or may violate laws, regulations, etc.

(3) When the authorities deem it inappropriate

(Notification of change)

16. A GFP Member shall, in the event of any change in the following information provided to the GFP Secretariat at the time of registration:
